 - "Mysterious Workings of the Adolescent Brain"
 - *Presentation must also include information from at least 3 other sources about your topic
 - *Be prepared to answer questions from the audience
 - *Use 5 Vocabulary Words make sure to highlight or bold
- Campaign Poster
 - * A public awareness poster with a persuasive slogan
- Presentation
 - * A roughly 5-minute presentation

Slide 1: Title slide with your topic and group member names

Slide 2: Current policy about your topic, including current legal age and relevant statistics (article, TEDtalk, or outside source)

Slide 3: Informative slide about current brain development research (article, TEDtalk, or outside source)

Slide 4: Informative slide about current brain development research (article, TEDtalk, or outside source)

Slide 5: Policies in other countries/societies regarding your topic (outside source)

Slide 6: Your group's proposed policy regarding your topic (age, parental consent, other qualifications, etc.)

Slide 7: Persuasive slide #1 (use ethos, pathos, and/or logos to persuade)

Slide 8: Persuasive slide #2 (use ethos, pathos, and/or logos to persuade)

Slide 9: Persuasive slide #3 (use ethos, pathos, and/or logos to persuade)

Slide 10: Wrap up your group's main idea and re-state why people should change their mind regarding your topic

*After slide 10, be prepared to answer questions from your audience.
