He is thinking about his beloved Lenore.



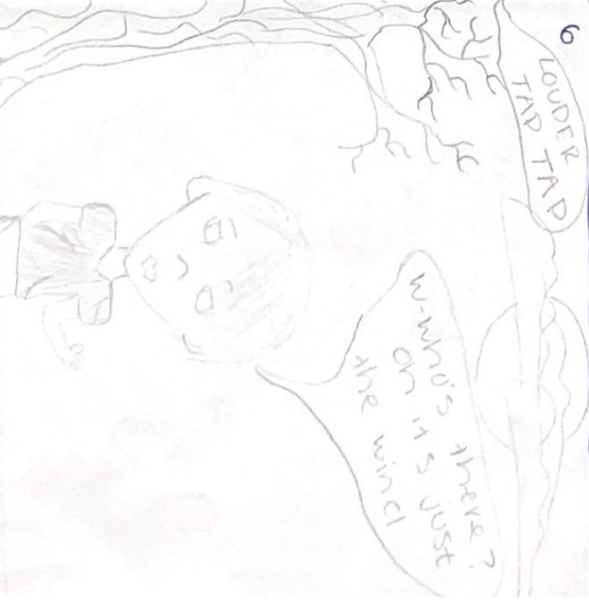
He sees his purple curtains move and is scared. He reassures himself it's just his visitor.

A louder tap he hears this time but he says it's just the wind and nothing more.



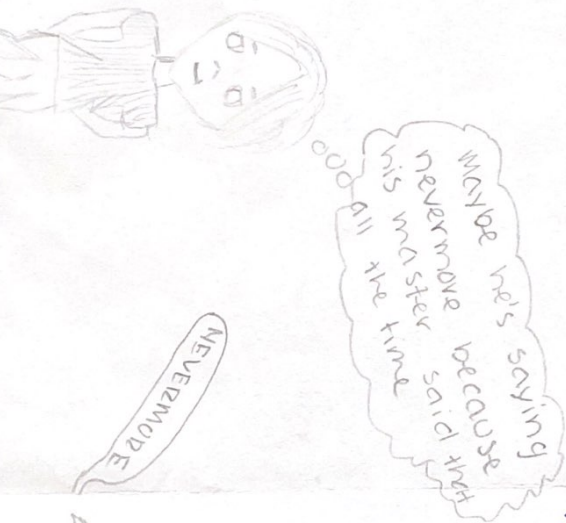
He opened the shutter when a raven stepped inside his home.



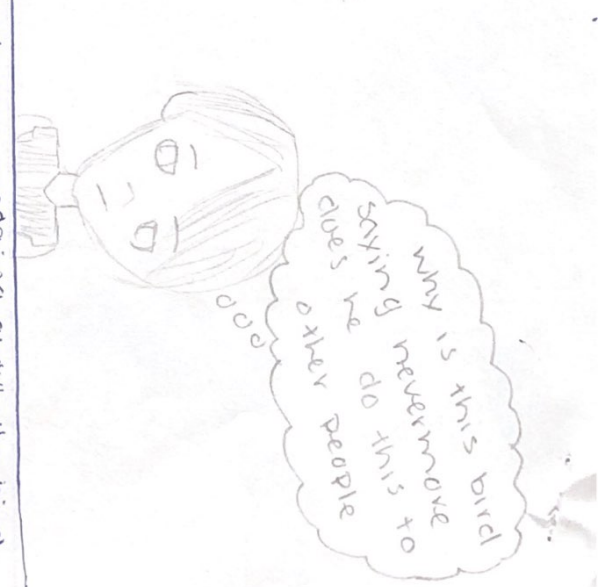
He says this has happened to me before tomorrow he'll probably leave.

He's still pondering about the bird and wonders if the bird harasses other humans.

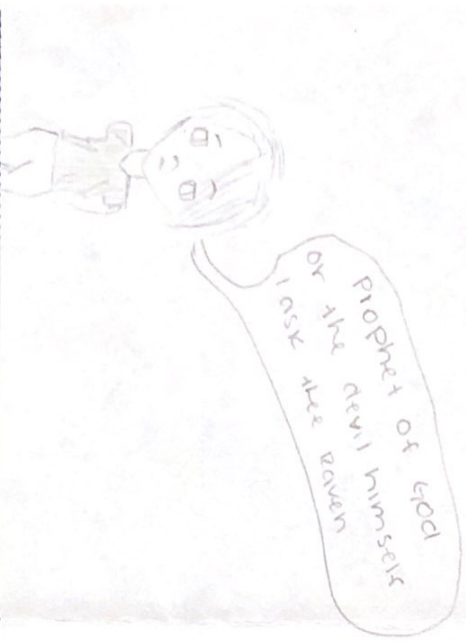


The raven is charming some smiles out of his sad and lonely soul.

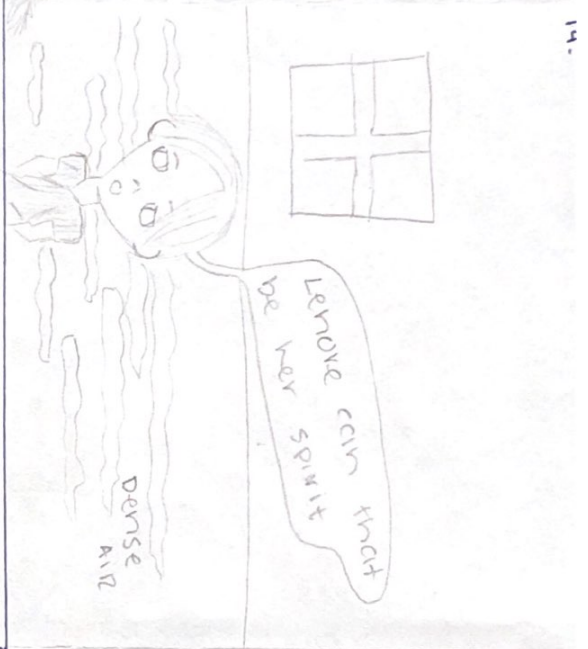


The man sat guessing why the Raven kept saying "nevermore".

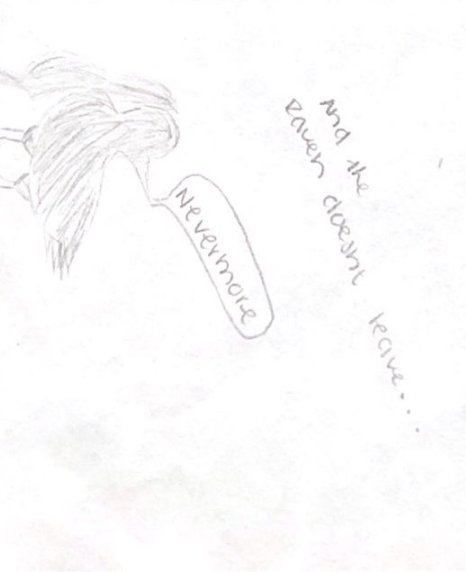


He wants the Raven to leave and go back where it came from. He's frustrated at the bird.
